HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

- This competition is organised in accordance with the Health and Safety legislation and therefore we ask:
- Emergency services must have access to all parts of the competition site at all times therefore members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access.
- All areas designated for horses only must be kept free of spectators at all times.
