Combined training:

You will ride a dressage test, and then complete a round of showjumps. Dressage marks will be converted to penalties, and any SJ penalties added to this. Lowest score wins. You can pick any height of SJ, but please state on entry which height you wish to jump.

CT SJ will be 1st round score only. If you jump clear you will go into jump off..

Run according the British Riding Club rules 2019

- Competitors must be ready to go into the class when called.
- The judges decision is final. Any competitors or their helpers being abusive to any judge, steward or secretary will be asked to leave the showground, forfeiting their entry.
- Please avoid riding horses in the Car park area, as this may present a danger to the General public
- Please pick up all horse droppings, and place them into the designated container in the Car park area.

between 21 and 92 days after the first • all annual boosters given AFTER 1 January 2014 are correct. Leap years will be ignored for an annual booster, but for the two primary injections and first booster injection, the days must be counted and therefore a leap year would interfere with the correct number of days between injections. Horses may compete at BRC Competitions providing that they have had the first two primary injections. No injection should have been given on any of the 6 days before a competition or entry to championship stables. For example: if the horse is vaccinated on the Monday, the horse will not be eligible to enter compete until the following Monday. In the event of failure to comply with any of the requirements of this rule, the horse or pony will be disqualified and not permitted to take part in any competition to which these rules apply..
