**Class 1: Open Working Hunter - Horse:** Horses exc 153cms, Max height of fences 85cms (**Novice Qualifier**). As per Willberry NoS Championship Show Schedule - Class 31.

**Class 2: Eastern BMW / BHS Scotland Riding Club - Working Hunter Series 2017 -  
QUALIFIER**

**Final: Blair Castle International Horse Trials**

**Eligibility:** Horses must be 15hh and over. Horses must not have won more than £400 in total in any WH competitions, more than £400 in BS winnings or have more than 45 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or over on 1 Jan 2017.

**Course:** You will be asked to jump a course of 8-12 fences approx 3'3" in height. Classes will be judged in line with Sport Horse Breeding Society of GB rules. You can [download a copy of the rules here](#) Hats must conform to the BRC rulebook.

**Qualification:** The first three partnerships in each qualifier will qualify for the final even if they did not jump clear. If one of the first three has already qualified, their qualification can be passed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they jumped clear. To be eligible for the final, the rider must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.

**Class 3: Stewarts Building Services / BHS Scotland - Working Hunter Series 2017 -  
QUALIFIER**

**Final: Blair Castle International Horse Trials**

**Eligibility:** Horses must be 15hh or over, 4 years old and over. Riders must be 18 years old or over. To compete at the final, either the rider or owner of the horse must be a member of the BHS. Course: 8-12 fences approx 3'6", judged in line with Sports Horse GB rules. You can find [a copy of the rules here](#)

**Qualifying:** The first three partnerships will qualify even if they have not jumped clear. If one of these has already qualified, their qualification may be handed down to the fourth placed horse and rider provided they had a clear round in the jumping.

To compete at the FINAL riders must be a **BHS Member** and this must be registered prior to the date of the final.

**Class 4: Beginners Working Hunter. Cross poles only. No fillers.** Open to any age or height. Does not go into Championship. May not compete in Intermediate or Open classes.

**Class 5: Novice working Hunter Pony:** Ponies not exc 153cms, Max height of fences 60cms. (**Cradle Stake Qualifier** - pony's under 12hh, Rider over 5, not to have attained 11<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan in current year). As per Willberry NoS Championship Show Schedule - Class 32.

**Class 6: Novice Working Hunter - Horse:** Horses exc 153cms, Max height of fences 60cms.

**Class 7: Intermediate Working Hunter Pony:** Ponies not exc 153cms, Max height of fences 75cms (**Nursery Stake Qualifier** - pony's under 13hh, Rider not to have attained 13<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> Jan in current year). As per Willberry NoS Championship Show Schedule - Class 33.

**Class 8: Intermediate Working Hunter - Horse:** Horses exc 153cms, Max height of fences 75cms.

**Class 9: Open Working Hunter Pony:** Ponies not exc 153cms, Max height of fences 85cms (**Novice Qualifier**) As per Willberry NoS Championship Show Schedule - Class 35.

Championship. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed in each class (excluding class 4)

### **Showjumping & Style Jumping – Ring 2 Starting at 10:00** Judge: Sandra Morrison

<b>Class 10</b>	<b>50-60cm</b>	Lead rein or assisted.
<b>Class 11</b>	<b>60cm</b>	Horses/Ponies not to have been placed in 70cm or above classes
<b>Class 12</b>	<b>65cm</b>	Style jumping – open to adults and juniors
<b>Class 13</b>	<b>70cm</b>	Horses/Ponies not to have been placed in 80cm or above classes
<b>Class 14</b>	<b>75cm</b>	Style Jumping – open to adults and juniors
<b>Class 15</b>	<b>80cm</b>	SJ - Open to all

**Eligibility:** Horses must be 4yo or over. No height restrictions. Horses must not have won more than £175 BS or have more than 10 BE points. Riders must be 18yo or older on 1 Jan 2017 and must not have competed in any FEI competition or be an FBHS or have taken their BHSII exams in the last 10 years. To compete at the final, the rider of the horse must be a member of a riding club affiliated to BRC.

**The course:** The course will have 8 to 12 obstacles, maximum 85cm in height with a maximum spread of 90cm one of which should be a double. All aspects of the course should comply with BS standards. The optimum speed for this competition is set at 325mpm. One penalty point will be deducted for every second over the optimum time.

**Qualification:** The first three partnerships will qualify for the final.

**Juniors must wear an approved body protector for the Showjumping.** Adults are strongly recommended to wear a body protector for the Showjumping.

#### **Rules for Working Hunter.**

Horses/ ponies and rider combinations may enter max of 2 Working Hunter Classes. 2<sup>nd</sup> class entered will not be eligible for championship a second time if placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in both classes.

- **Classes 2 - 4:** Riders must be a suitable size for the pony ridden.
- **Classes 2:** Ponies not to have been placed more than 3 times at Novice level, or in height classes 60cm or above.
- **Classes 3:** Ponies not to have been placed more than 3 times at Intermediate level, or in height classes 75cm or above.

- **Classes 4:** Ponies not to have been placed more than 3 times at Novice level, or in height classes 85cm or above.
- **Classes 5:** Horses not to have been placed more than 3 times at Novice level, or in height classes 60cm or above.
- **Classes 6:** Horses not to have been placed more than 3 times at Intermediate level, or in height classes 75cm or above.
- **Classes 7:** Horses not to have been placed more than 3 times at Novice level, or in height classes 85cm or above.
- The judges reserve the right to ask competitors to move to a different class if they feel they are unfairly entered.
- In WH Championships, horses/ponies must be ridden by the same rider that rode them in the class.

### **General rules.**

- Competitors must be ready to go into the class when called.
- Once judging has commenced, no further entries will be allowed into the ring.
- Buchan RC and its committee cannot be held responsible for classes clashing. It is up to the competitors to choose which class they wish to compete in, if this occurs.
- 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each class will be eligible for the Ring Championship at the end of each Section (not including class 1).
- The Overall Championship will take place at the conclusion of all class judging.
- The judge's decision is final. Any competitors or their helpers being abusive to any judge, steward or secretary will be asked to leave the showground, forfeiting their entry.
- Please avoid riding horses in the Car park area, as this may present a danger to the General public
- Please pick up all horse droppings, and place them into the designated container in the Horse box parking area.
